<u>The cause of celebrity culture is an immature</u> Christian faith.

<u>The symptoms</u> of celebrity culture are <u>jealousy</u> and <u>strife</u>.

The Solution to celebrity culture:

- 1) Affirm the <u>equality</u> of all people and the <u>supremacy</u> of God.
- 2) Focus on our work for God.
