What is Evangelism?

Evangelism is teaching the Gospel, the good news about Jesus Christ, with the aim to pursuade.

Key truths about evangelism:

- 1) Passion is the <u>fuel</u> for evangelism.
- 2) Evangelism is a godly purpose.
- 3) It is <u>wise</u> to develop a process for evangelism.

Questions for prayer and reflection:

1) **Do you have a passion for evangelism? Why or why not?** (Mat. 28:18-20, Acts 1:6-10, 2:14-41, 2 Cor. 5:20-21, 1 Peter 3:13-17)

- 2) Do you share the purpose of winning people for Christ or do you feel uncomfortable trying to pursued people to convert to Christianity? Why? (1 Cor. 9:19-24)
- 3) What regular process do you have in your life to tell others about Jesus?
