WHAT'S HOLDING YOU BACK?

- 1) Why did the ruler ask how to inherit eternal life?
 - Nothing in the world lasts forever.
- 2) Why does Jesus answer as he does?
 - To reveal the <u>choice</u> between the world and the Kingdom of God.
- 3) Why did the ruler walk away sad?
 - Earthly wealth was <u>valued</u> more than eternal life.
- 4) Why do riches make it difficult to enter the Kingdom of God?
 - Riches make it easier to love the world.

Luke 16:13 ... "No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

Further Study

- 1. The rich young ruler and Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10) have opposite reactions to their encounter with Jesus. Does your life more closely resemble the rich young ruler or Zacchaeus? In what ways?
- 2. For the rich young ruler, his wealth was holding him back from following Jesus, but that is not the case for everyone (John 3, Luke 4:16-30, Luke 9:57-62, John 6:22-71). Is there something holding you back from following Jesus?
