

THE RIGHTEOUS FOR THE UNRIGHTEOUS 1 PETER 3:18-22

The plain things are the main things ...

- 1) Christ's one sacrifice on the cross covers <u>all</u> our sins.
- 2) God gave His <u>righteous</u> Son to redeem <u>unrighteous</u> People.
- 3) Suffering is <u>overshadowed</u> by the resurrection
- 2 Corinthians 4:17–18 ... "For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal."
- 4) Jesus Christ is sovereign.

How to study a hard passage of the Bible

- Start with Prayer Don't miss this.
- **Immediate Context** Study the verses around the primary verse
- **Book Context** Study the whole book. Look for related passages and know the genre, author, recipients, and purpose for which the book was written.
- **Biblical Context** Study related passages in the Bible.
- **Historical Context** Study other works outside of the Bible which can enlighten understanding.
- **Commentaries** Study what others have discovered about the passage.
