

# POLITY: WHAT IS IT AND WHY DOES IT MATTER?

#### <u>1 PETER 5:1-4</u>

What does God's word prescribe for how a church is governed?

1) Jesus Christ is the <u>head</u> of the <u>church</u>.

Colossians 1:18 ... "And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent."

- 2) The Bible is our <u>chief authority</u>.
- 3) The congregation is active in governing the church
- 4) Pastors are church officers who <u>lead</u> the church to follow Christ.
  - a) The term elder, pastor, and overseer are used synonymously in the New Testament.
  - b) The character of a pastor is more important than the skills of a pastor.
- 5) Deacons are church officers who <u>serve</u> the church.

### **Questions to Consider**

- 1) Why is the way a church government structured important? (Think of examples of how poor church government has caused problems.)
- 2) What are key elements of the biblical model for church governance?
  Acts 20:17-38, 1 Timothy 3:1-10, 5:17-25, Titus 1:5-9, 1 Peter 5:1-5
- 3) Why is character more important than skill for a elder/ pastor of a church?
- 4) In what ways do we often emphasize the skills of Pastors more than the character of pastors?
