

### THE LION OF JUDAH

#### 1 PETER 5:6-11 REVELATION 5:5

- 1) The only safe place from the <u>attacks</u> of the <u>devil</u> is under the <u>protection</u> of <u>Jesus</u>. (Rev. 5:5-7)
- 2) God's <u>salvation</u> comes through <u>suffering</u>. (Rev. 5:8-10)
- 3) God's salvations <u>secures</u> us in our <u>struggles</u>.
- 4) In Christ, our suffering is <u>temporary</u>, but God's love and care for us is eternal.

1 Peter 5:9–10 ... "Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brother-hood throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you."
