Key Scripture: Matthew 4:1-11

What to do When we are Tempted Part 2

Prepare for temptation:

- 1) **Stay alert** when God is beginning something new in our life or when we are weak. (When will the battle take place?)
- 2) **Recognize the sources** of temptation: ourselves, the world, the devil. (Who/what is tempting us?)
- Know the types of temptation: The desires of the flesh, the desires of the eyes, the pride of life. (How will we be tempted?)
 - a) <u>Physical</u> desire. (Lust of the flesh)
 - b) Desire to <u>possess</u> something. (Lust of the eyes)
 - c) Desire for <u>significance</u>. (The pride of life.
- 4) **Prepare** to <u>defend</u> against giving into temptation.
 - a) Develop <u>faith</u> in God.
 - b) Rely on God's provision.



- c) Trust in God's comfort.
- d) Apply God's word.
