

Methods of the Holy Spirit

 The work of the Holy Spirit <u>precedes</u> us, <u>continues</u> through us, and carries on <u>after</u> us. The Holy Spirit was at work in Timothy's life before Paul encountered him and through Paul's ministry.

(Acts 16:1-5, 2 Timothy 1:5

2) The Holy Spirit works through <u>opening</u> and <u>closing</u> doors.

The Holy Spirit prevented Paul from going into Asia and guided him to Macedonia. (Acts 16:6-10)

3) The Holy Spirit does the <u>heart</u> work we cannot do.

The Holy Spirit opened Lydia's heart. (Acts 16:14)

4) The Holy Spirit works through carefully <u>reasoned</u> arguments.

Reasoned arguments were at the center of Paul's work to preach the Gospel. (Acts 16:13; 17:2, 11, 17; 18:4, 19)

5) The Holy Spirit works through <u>struggle</u> and <u>injustice</u>.

Priscilla and Aquilla were in Corinth when Paul arrived because Emperor Claudius commanded Jews to leave Rome. (Acts 18:2)

6) Our <u>trust</u> is in the Holy Spirit, not ourselves.

1 Corinthians 3:5–6 ... "What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth."
