

## The Holy Spirit Goes With Us Acts 27-28

## 1) When all earthly hope is gone, God gives us hope which never <u>leaves</u>.

John 14:16 ... "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever,"

Psalm 20:7 ... "Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God."

## 2) When life <u>hurts</u>, God gives us reason to give thanks.

Acts 27:33–35 ... "As day was about to dawn, Paul urged them all to take some food, saying, "Today is the fourteenth day that you have continued in suspense and without food, having taken nothing. Therefore I urge you to take some food. For it will give you strength, for not a hair is to perish from the head of any of you." And when he had said these things, he took bread, and giving thanks to God in the presence of all he broke it and began to eat."

- 1) What role does the Holy Spirit play in the hope you have?
- 2) Does it matter who you give thanks to? Why or why not?
- 3) When is it hardest for you to give thanks?
- 4) When is a time your heart has been dull to the Lord? If it was in the past, what happened that revived your love and passion for Him?
