#### What does God desire for us?

- 1) <u>Contentment</u> in all circumstances. (Mat. 6:25-34, 1 Tim. 6:6-8)
- 2) <u>Joy</u> in our trials. (Rom. 5:3-5, James 1:2.)
- 3) Purpose in our positions. (Eph. 2:10, Esther 4:14)
- 4) <u>Confidence</u> in God's sovereignty. (Mat. 7:7-11, Prv. 3:5-6)
